Have you ever considered the benefits of substituting at one of our Alternative Schools? Here are just a few reasons to consider a sub position at Abraxas and FIRST:

- Small class sizes

Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center operates the following alternative schools:

Abraxas School serves students who reside in the Abraxas Private Residential Treatment Facility. Abraxas is a locked, secure treatment facility serving juvenile males. It is located at 2775 State Route 39 in Shelby.

FIRST Program serves students who reside in the Foundations for Living Private Residential Treatment Facility, which is a locked, secure treatment facility serving juvenile males and females. It is located at 1451 Lucas Road in Mansfield.

Our Alternative Schools serve a unique population of students and our teachers find the experience very rewarding. If you are interested in seeing the facilities before subbing, we offer tours.
