GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Middle/High school math teacher within a private, residential treatment facility serving students of various ages.

- Knowledge of Ohio Learning Standards for Mathematics
- Must successfully pass a BCI/FBI background check

- Evaluate and report student's academic progress to appropriate individuals through: mid-term grades, end-of-term grades, and special education/IEP specific needs and goals
- Assist in the development of school curriculum
- Assist in the selection of instructional materials
- Attend Abraxas school meetings/PD and Abraxas meetings/PD as requested
- Perform other related duties as may be assigned by the Educational Director of Abraxas
- Collaborate with Intervention Specialists to ensure identified accommodations/supports are being provided in the classroom.
- All other duties as assigned by the Principal of Abraxas
