- Educator in the past four years and has completed the Ohio required modules (HB 33)
- Also seeking retired educators with recent experience (within the last four years) who are familiar with requirements for educators regarding dyslexia and the hallmarks of the science of reading

What non-negotiable qualifications must I have?

- Ohio Educator License (at least effective through July 1, 2027, No out of state licenses will be considered)
- Experience teaching at least 3-5 years min that included reading/literacy instruction or content teacher that has tutored reading
- One of these-MA in Literacy/ Reading and/or IDA accreditation through a vendor and/or higher education institute and/or a reading/coaching endorsement



- If MA in curriculum, early or middle childhood, etc.. **must also have a** reading endorsement or IDA accreditation through a vendor or higher education institute
