INFORMATION REGARDING ABRAXAS AND FIRST SCHOOLS

Have you ever considered the benefits of substituting at one of our Alternative Schools? Here are just a few reasons to consider a sub position at Abraxas and FIRST:

- Small class sizes
- Grades 7 through 12
- Substitute even when other schools are closed for snow days
- Work during the summer
- Abraxas and the FIRST Program are in session all year
- *Earn \$140 per day*

Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center operates the following alternative schools:

Abraxas School serves students who reside in the Abraxas Private Residential Treatment Facility. Abraxas is a locked, secure treatment facility serving juvenile males. A typical educational day at Abraxas is 9:00 a.m. until 3:45 p.m. It is located at 2775 State Route 39 in Shelby.

FIRST Program serves students who reside in the Foundations for Living Private Residential Treatment Facility, which is a locked, secure treatment facility serving juvenile males and females. The students are educated separately. For a substitute teacher, a typical classroom day is 7:30 a.m. until 2:15 p.m. The FIRST Program is located at 1451 Lucas Road in Mansfield.

Our Alternative Schools serve a unique population of students and our teachers find the experience very rewarding. If you are interested in seeing the facilities before subbing, we offer tours.
