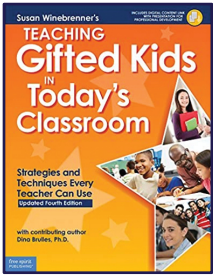

Work at your own pace from June 1 - August 15, 2021

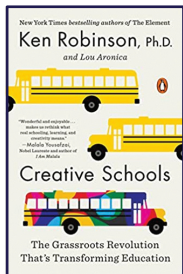
Participants will independently complete the reading and the assigned implementation project

### Creative Schools: The Grassroots Revolution That's Transforming Education

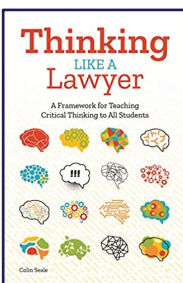

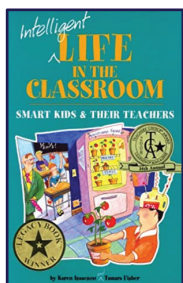
### Thinking Like a Lawyer
